A New Model of Ministry in the Laurentians

This month marks the beginning of a new model for the delivery of ministry in ten Anglican Churches in the Laurentians: Grace Church - Arundel, Holy Trinity Church - Ste Agathe, Trinity Church - Morin Heights, St. Francis of the Birds Church - St. Sauveur, Christ Church - Mille Isles, Holy Trinity Church - Lakefield, St. Aidan's Church - Louisa/Wentworth, St. Paul's Church - Dunany, St. Simeon's Church - Lachute and St. John the Baptist in the Wilderness Church - Kilkenny.

These ten churches will share the services of two full time priests, the Venerable Ralph Leavitt and the Reverend Nicholas Pang. Both have been appointed by the Bishop. The churches will also be supported by ten Lay Readers/Lay Leaders. All members of this ministry team will rotate throughout the region to provide Sunday services. Archdeacon Ralph Leavitt will live in Ste. Agathe and Revd. Nicholas Pang in Lachute, each in a church rectory, supported financially by the ten churches. As we have been doing in the PLL, all churches will contribute a given amount to finance this arrangement. The hope is that each church's overall costs will be reduced compared to what we have been paying for many years where each parish hired its own priest for varying percentages of time.

Apart from this, life should continue much as it has. Each church will continue to look after its own affairs and make its own decisions, just as we do in the PLL. As members of the PLL, we have already had several years of working with a similar model and so the adjustment should be a little easier for us than for congregations who have been accustomed to having a full time priest.

This new regional ministry is in its infancy and will require patience and accommodation from everyone. Change is never easy – especially for Anglicans, I am told. © Service times have changed in most churches in an attempt to allow the priests sufficient travel time from their first service on a Sunday to their second. We will have to see how things work out and modify where necessary. It is new to all of us and so it is a work in progress.

We pray that the spirit of generosity and family that has emerged in the PLL over the past few years will be present and encourage a similar sense of cooperation and fellowship among this new grouping of churches.
